BOIL WATER NOTICE UPDATE

This is a follow-up notice to the Boil Water Warning issued on April 10, 2019.

The boil water notice issued previously for the Warm Springs Agency Water System will remain in effect until further notice.

Following the return of the results of a second round of water testing, it is anticipated that the notice will be lifted. This is expected to occur sometime on Monday, April 15, 2019.

Early Childhood Education (ECE), which includes Day Care and Head Start, will be closed again on Monday, April 15, 2019.

Until the EPA provides documentation to allow the notice to be lifted please adhere to all warnings and information provided in the Boil Water Warning notices.

DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST

- As a reminder, the notice relates **to the consumption of water** and does not prohibit other daily uses such as bathing, washing or sanitary uses (flushing toilets).
- Please monitor your children as they bathe to make sure they do not drink the water.
- Bring all water to a rolling boil for at least (3) minutes, and let cool before using. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms that may be in the water.
- Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation.
- All stored water or ice made recently should be discarded.
- Resources and funds are limited; water on hand will be distributed at the Old School Library until 6:00pm today or until we run out. No week-end distribution.
