

HOW TO APPLY

- Application due **MARCH 1**
- Apply online using the Office of Student Access and Completion (OSAC) scholarship application at www.OregonStudentAid.gov
- As soon as possible after October 1, file Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* at www.fafsa.gov

ELIGIBILITY

- Most of The Ford Family Foundation Scholarship Programs are need-based and require applicants to demonstrate financial need by filing the FAFSA*.
- Recipients must enroll full time, on campus in the fall of the application year.
- Not for students with an existing bachelor's degree.

- Age 21 or younger
- Can be used at any college in the United States
