“As of 5:05p on 7/8/2020 – Warm Springs Health and Wellness Center has sent in or tested **1247 Total Tests, 1107 Total Negative, 41 Test Pending, 94 Total Positive Cases, 5 Total Invalid, 7 Hospitalized, 4 Discharged, 62 Recovered.** Note - the STATE lab is taking 24-48 hours for results and our maximum daily capacity for Rapid tests is 20-22. Our test kit inventory currently stands at 294 STATE and 287 ABBOTT (Rapid) test kits. We continue to do random surveillance testing of our high-risk community members, our healthcare and first responder staff, and we continue to conduct broader surveillance of the CTWS employees, as the community has reopened.” Hyllis D.
