Dear Families,

This letter provides you with some very important information about the return to in-person learning. We appreciate you taking the time to read this and please follow up with us if you have any questions.

Dates to Remember:

- CASA Students will have school February 1 and 2. Meal deliveries will be uninterrupted
- February 1 No School for students planning to return for in-person learning and no CDL
- February 2 No School for students planning to return for in-person learning and no CDL
- February 3 First Day of In-Person Instruction K-8 and no CDL

Please note, now that we are returning to in-person learning, teachers will no longer provide CDL. CASA is available for families choosing not to return in person.

Please enjoy this informative video on <u>Safety procedures for WSK8</u>. We will continue to build on these procedures as needed to keep students and staff safe.

We have protocols in place for moving through the school day.

- All elementary classrooms will be divided into cohorts (staying with the same group of students). Middle school students will have a minimal number of stable cohorts.
- Breakfast and lunch will be in classrooms.
- Students will physically distance themselves when using the bathrooms.
- Strict cleaning protocols, physical distancing, and mask-wearing will be enforced and followed at all times.
- Arrival drop-off locations and dismissal will be by grade-levels.

Middle school students will have a five-period day, transitioning between classrooms minimally. Students and staff will be in stable cohorts throughout the day, including during lunch, breaks, and/or recesses.

The school day will be **9:15 am to 3:25 pm. School starts at 9:25 am.** Students should *not arrive* before 9:15 am and shall be picked up by 3:25 pm. *For any bus changes, please call the school or set up a pick-up patrol account.*

When picking-up or dropping-off, please follow appropriate signage, also shown in the safety procedures video. Students need to stay physically distanced even outside.

- 6th, 7th, and 8th-grade students are dropped off at the front, walk around the side of the building, and enter their hallway from outside.
- Just past the main office, is the 3rd, 4th, and 5th-grade drop-off and they walk around to enter the hallway from outside.
- Along the side parking lot, we have the last drop-off for K, 1st, and 2nd. They enter their hallway from outside. Please take care to keep out of the bus lanes.

Students should bring the following supplies to school:

- The computer and charger that was provided by the District.
- The supplies that the school provided. These will be used by the student in the classroom. (Supplies will not be shared between students to the maximum extent possible)
- A refillable water bottle.
