

Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

A Federal Communications Commission program to help households on tribal lands afford internet service during the pandemic. Eligible households can receive:

- Up to \$75/month discount for internet service on tribal lands
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer or tablet through a participating provider.

Household must meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- Have an income that is at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or participates in certain government assistance programs;
- Receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch or breakfast program;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Experienced a substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.
