A. TODAY'S AIR QUALITY INDEX ratings (Particle Size: 2.5 microns):

B. FORECAST: Weather Station: Warm Springs, Elevation: **2507 feet**.

Patchy smoke between noon and 3pm. Sunny and hot, with a high near 101. Calm wind becoming north 5 to 7 mph in the afternoon.

Temperature: 59°. SSE 4 mph.

POLLEN/ALLERGY LEVEL- Medium-high- 9.5: Pollen levels between 7.3 and 9.6 tend to affect a large number of individuals who suffer from the pollen types of the season.

Top allergens: Grasses and Juniper.

Allergy Forecast: Pollen levels for Tuesday will be in the medium-high range.

SUN ENERGY/UV: UV Index: Very High-10: Protection against sun damage is needed. If you need to be outside during midday hours between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., take steps to reduce sun exposure.
