ELECTION & COUNTING BOARDS

ELECTION BOARD - 3 VACANCIES + 1 ALTERNATE COUNTING BOARD - 4 VACANCIES + 1 ALTERNATE

ORDINANCE #44

8. <u>Election Boards</u>. For each election, the Tribal Council shall appoint an election board for each polling place, the election board to be composed of the following officials: Three members of the Election board. One alternate member of the Election board. One interpreter.

The Tribal Council will appoint one of the three members as the Chairman of the Election Board and in the event that any of the three members of the Election Board shall be unable to serve or shall resign, then the alternate shall replace any such member.

- 9. <u>Counting Board</u>. For each election, the Tribal Council shall appoint a Counting Board for the purpose of counting the results of the elections. The Counting board shall consist of four persons and the Tribal Council will appoint one of the four members as Chairman.
- 10. <u>Eligibility for Membership to Election and Counting Boards</u>. All members of the Election Boards and Counting Boards shall be members of the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon, and shall not be appointed to such positions in an election where they or a member of their immediate family are a candidate for election or where they may personally have an interest in the election different from the interests of the membership at large.
- 11. <u>Duties of Election Boards</u>. It shall be the duty of the election board to supervise the election at the voting place where they are designated to serve. The Vital Statistics Department Supervisor shall furnish to the election board an up to date voter list showing the district in which each of the voters is entitled to vote and insofar as the election board is concerned such voter list shall be final. The election board shall insure that all persons whose names are shown on the voter list shall have an opportunity to vote in the district where they are registered and that no persons whose names are not on the voting list for that district shall vote. Invalids and persons hospitalized or incarcerated and unable to travel to the voting place shall have their ballots collected by a two person team composed of a member of the Election Board and a member of the Counting Board.
- 12. <u>Date, Place and Hours of Election and Disputes</u>. The Tribal Council shall establish the date of election, the voting places and the hours during which the polls shall be open. The Tribal Council shall furnish ballots to the election boards and the election boards shall guarantee that all registered voters have the opportunity to vote a secret ballot. Decisions on all dispute shall be decided by the election board assigned to the particular voting place and such decision shall be final.
