The 32nd Annual Tribal Member Adult and Youth Art Exhibit, will be displayed from Wednesday, November 12, 2025 5:30PM through Saturday, March 7, 2026 at The Museum at Warm Springs. We request your participation by submitting your artwork. We welcome contemporary, traditional, and video art (includes short film and music videos). Your items will be displayed in The Museum's Changing Exhibits Gallery.

For the Tribal Member Adults (18 years of age and older), art will be observed by a neutral judge. For the adult Tribal Member artwork to be judged, please submit your work on or before the deadline of Tuesday, October 14th, 2025 at 5pm. The Judge's Choice categories include: Contemporary, Traditional, and Video. There will also be Honorable Mention Awards. Artists selected for an award will be notified. For all other artists, for display purposes only, whose art will not be judged (TM adult and Youth) the deadline will be the following Tuesday, October 21, 2025 at 5pm. The application will include the guidelines and contract.

For Tribal Member Youth (17 years of age and younger) Art, there will be a separate application form (one form will be for a parent or guardian and the other will be for teachers that have submissions for their entire class). Please encourage all of the young artists that you know to participate in the exhibit.

The reception and exhibit opening will be on Wednesday, November 12, 2025 from 5:30pm to 7:30pm. Listen for announcements on KWSO and also look for our Facebook page for reminders.
